■ A handwashing sink is not accessible for employee use at all times, is used for purposes other than handwashing or is not operated properly, specifically: Kitchen hand sink has water turned off due to leak, hand sink in ice cream area is blocked by equipment. **Point deduction: 3.**

ABOUT RESTAURANT INSPECTIONS
This is a snapshot of the inspections conducted by the Marion and Polk County health departments.
Twice annually, licensed restaurants receive unannounced inspections that focus on food temperatures, food preparation practices, worker hygiene, dish-washing and sanitizing, and equipment and facility cleanliness.
Violations: Restaurant scores are based on a 100-point scale. Priority violations deduct 5 points, and priority foundation violations deduct 3 points. Violations recorded on consecutive inspections result in point deductions being doubled.
Scoring: Scores of 70 or higher are considered compliant. Restaurants scoring below 70 must be re-inspected within 30 days or face closure or other administrative action. Restaurants display a placard by the entrance to indicate whether they have passed their last inspection.
Food trucks, carts and trailers: Mobile food operators do not receive a numerical score. They are either approved to operate or not approved to operate.

■ Raw or ready-to-eat food is not properly protected from cross-contamination, specifically: Boxes of raw chicken stored above kegs inside the walk-in refrigerator. **Point deduction: 5.**
■ Potentially hazardous food is not maintained at proper hot or cold holding temperatures, specifically: Corn 46°F, pico de gallo 48°F, cream mix 46-48°F in the back left corner of the south cookline refrigerator. Asada 118-127°F and chicken 109-129°F in metal pan on burner stove. Cooked chorizo stored on top

shelf above the grill without temperature control. Ground beef 125-134°F, green sauce 118-130°F and Chile Colorado 109-128°F at steamer unit. Container of beans at other end of the steamer measured about 127°F in the center. **Point deduction: 5.**

Hot dogs 126°F in steamer at the store's hot hold station. Burgers 101°F at the burger hot case, no time discard stamp on package. **Point deduction: 5.**
■ The wash compartment of the sink or mechanical dishwasher does not contain a wash solution with a cleaning agent, specifically: No detergent inside the dishwasher, container empty. **Point deduction: 3.**
June 13: Priority violations
■ Potentially hazardous food is not maintained at proper hot or cold holding temperatures, specifically: Ground pork 53°F, sliced cheese 48-51°F, sour cream 45°F, and diced ham 45°F stored in metal containers on the cold rail section at the cookline. Hot dogs 117-123°F in steamer at the store's hot hold station. Burgers 121-128°F at the burger hot case, no time discard stamp on package. **June 25: No priority violations**

■ (REPEAT) A handwashing sink is not accessible for employee use at all times, is used for purposes other than handwashing or is not operated properly, specifically: Pitcher lid stored inside the handwashing sink (south side). Staff mention three-compartment sink is mostly used for handwashing and designated hand sink is used to rinse pitchers. **Point deduction: 6.**

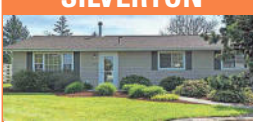

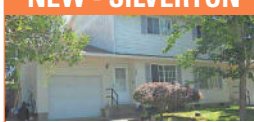
