CARE OF PLANTS. How to Protect Them and Make Them Grow.

The first thing about the care of plants is good drainage and the right kind of soil, says the New York Jour-nal. A little ammonia once a week in the water will act as a fertilizer and force the plants to bloom. The is much better than earthenware, because it keeps the plants moist longer. They do well in a poor soil and require little watering.
