LARGE NUMBERS OF HOMESEEEKERS

Are Now Coming to Oregon---Cheap Rates Commenced March 1---Many Will Invest--- Grande Ronde Valley.

The cheap home seekers' rates on all railroads terminating in the west went into effect on March 1, and the flood of immigration into Oregon has commenced. No. 1 was run in two sections yesterday morning. On the first section were 15 immigrant cars all filled with people seeking homes in Oregon. Some half dozen got off at this point and will look over Grande Ronde Valley. On the second section were about 10 cars of home seekers, and a number from this train also stopped off in La Grande.
Oregon just now is the Mecca of the rent laden farmers of the older states of the East who are endeavoring to better their condition. The young men for whom there seems to be no opening in the over crowded East are also looking to Oregon and other western states for a place in which to establish themselves in business and the professions. Almost every day will witness the arrival of those who are ready to grasp at opportunities and want to establish permanent homes, and there is no reason why La Grande cannot get her share of the influx of home builders.
But La Grande has a part to perform. The city should be made attractive. First impressions are often lasting and the homeseeker should be made to feel as soon as he gets off the train that "Here is the place I have been looking for."

HUNT THE DEAD

Relatives of the Victims of the Scaffold Disaster Threaten Lives of Guilty Contractors.

New York, March 3—Three hundred men worked all night in the ruins of the Hotel Darlington. At 10 this morning five bodies had been recovered and the rescuers report eight more in sight. One is cut cleanly in two.
The list of dead will not exceed 13, and 16 wounded are in hospitals.
The construction men are under arrest, and none of the contractors can be found. Open threats of violence against the contractors are made by surviving workmen and relatives of the killed and injured men.
Suit for damages aggregating \$500,000 have already been begun against the owners and contractors, on account of the death and injuries list, and a suit for \$5,000 by the owners of the Patterson apartment house adjoining.

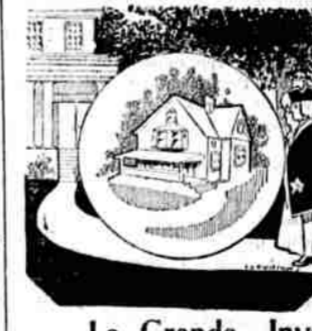
