### LOCAL OPTION.

The Commercial Tribune, of Cincinnati, Ohio, says:

"The Ohio legislature opened on January 6 and at midnight, Saturday, the 22nd of April, it closed. Among the important bills passed, that paper mentions the Bronson Local Option bill. This is a bill similar to the Local Option bill now pending before the voters of Oregon for them to vote on at the June election. It gives to the resident registered voters the right to say when a saloon or place for the sale of intoxicating liquors may or may not be operated in their district. The Oregon bill, if passed by a majority of the voters in June, will give to each precinct in the state the right to say whether or not they want a saloon.

The same Ohio legislature passed the Bronson Primary Election bill. This bill is also similar to the Primary Election bill that the registered voters of Oregon will vote upon next June.

Railroad men generally and the public will receive with approval the announcement that Mr Craig will remain. Since coming to the O. R. & N.
