The people of Elgin and La Grande are entitled to a better train service than they are now receiving. The one train a day service is not sufficient to meet the demands of the patrons of the road. Those who reside at the Elgin end of the line desire a service which will allow them to come to La Grande Saturday and return home before Monday. We at this end of the road would like to be able to transact a little business at Elgin and not be compelled to either go without dinner or remain over to the next day. We believe that if this matter is properly placed before the railroad officials they will be willing to arrange matters so that the patrons of the road will have better service. The O. R. & N. Co., has been very progressive and accommodating in its business dealings with its patrons and will no doubt see the advantage of some other arrangement if the matter is properly presented to them.

The Pacific Northwest is now receiving a large immigration from the east. All the transcontinental trains are heavily loaded with home seekers.
