THE 58TH CONGRESS

The Congress of the United States that adjourned a few days ago, began its first session on March the 4th, is composed of 90 Senators and 384 members of the House of Representatives and two vacancies.

In the Senate 32 are Democrats and 58 Republicans. Vice President Roosevelt having become President on the death of McKinley, left the Senate without a presiding officer whereupon, in accordance with the law, the Senate proceeded to elect one of its members presiding officer and the choice fell on Senator William P. Frye of Maine and he is now presiding officer of the U. S. Senate.

The House of Representatives when full contains 384 members, there are now two vacancies. Politically the House stands 174 Democrats, 206 Republicans and two Independents. The House elects one of its members for presiding officer called the Speaker. A bill to become a law must pass both houses and be approved by the president. If the president vetoes a bill he returns it to Congress and if two thirds of the members so vote it becomes a law, but if the president retains a bill ten days after receiving it from Congress and neither signs nor returns it, it becomes a law without his name.

There is multitude of bills presented at each session of Congress, and as a rule each bill is referred to an appropriate committee. The Senate has 58 standing committees the House has 43. It is in the committee rooms that the real work of Congress is done, a fact that makes members of Congress anxious to get on the committee before which the bill he is most anxious to pass will be referred.

Senator Fulton is a member of six committees, viz, Canadian Relations of which he is chairman, Claims, Fisheries, Irrigation, Public Lands and Industrial Expositions. These are all important committees. Senator Mitchell is on seven

committees, viz Coast Defense, of which he is chairman, Cuban relations, Inter-oceanic Canal, Judiciary, Pacific Islands Post Office and Post Roads and Women's Suffrage.

Our Congressmen are on three committees, Herman on two, Indian Affairs and Election of President and Vice President and Representatives to Congress. Williamson is on the committee of Mines and Mining, an important committee for a new member to get.

There should not be a dissenting vote on the relocation of the county seat to La Grande, from a resident who lives north of this city and when the voters understand that such a removal will in no wise increase their taxation there will be few dissenting votes and the voters will be assured on the taxation question before June 6th. In fact the Supreme court has thoroughly decided that question all ready.

LaGrande is a consuming city. The larger it grows the greater the market it furnishes to the farmers of this county.
