LOOK OUT.

Voters throughout the county are warned of reports that are liable to be sprung on the day of election that La Grande is cutting this or that candidate. This will be used for the purpose of making the friends of these candidates mad at La Grande in the hopes of getting them to

vote for Union on the county seat. La Grande has understood from the start that she is in no position to favor any single candidate and is not doing so. Every man on the democratic ticket will get his party vote in La Grande. Every man on the republican ticket will do the same, and this is true of all the parties. 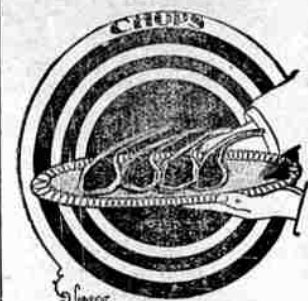
