Ordinance No 290 Series of 1904

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of La Grande, Oregon to enter into a written contract with J H Childs for the construction of trenches for water main for said City.

The City of La Grande does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of La Grande, Oregon be and hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a written contract with J H Childs for the construction of trenches for water main of said City; said Contract to be entered into upon the basis and in accordance with the terms of the proposition of said J. H. Childs accepted by the Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon on the 13th day of June A. D. 1904.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in the La Grande Evening Observer for one issue thereof and shall be in full force and take effect from and after the 20th day of June A. D. 1904.

Passed by the Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon on the 13th day of June A. D. 1904, by six members voting therefor.
