TWO DAYS CONVENTION.

There assembled today in Chicago Illinois, the 12 National Convention of the Republican Party, the greatest statesmen of the nation. The Republican States, who are fortunate in having men of national reputation as statesmen in the U. S. Senate or in the House of Representatives, have sent them to join with governors, ex-governors and other intellectual giants to formulate a platform declarative of the principles, policies and purposes of the party, and to ratify a spontaneous and universal desire of the common people that Theodore Roosevelt continue in the execution chair of the nation for another four years from the 4th of March next and that Republican policies shall be carried out in the future in this great and prosperous nation.

The Russian governor general of Finland has been assassinated, it is presumed by some one of the discontented people. For some time Russia has attempted to obliterate Finnish nationality by extreme measures. Hitherto the people have been privileged to enjoy their own laws and have their language taught in the schools; but within the last few years these franchises have been changed. The mother tongue of the people has been ruled out of educational institutions, and the Russian language introduced instead. Then the attempt has been made to Russianize the Finns by forbidding certain customs and making them liable to conscription in the army. These have caused great discontent among the

people, and thousands have left their native land to make homes elsewhere. Those who have remained have nurtured a spirit of resistance to the autocratic rule, and killing Gen. Bobrikoff, the representative of the Czar as governor-general of the province, is a matter of no great surprise. Of course the murderer will be punished and any uprising suppressed. But more cruelty will be enacted and this will sow the seeds of bitterness that will bear unpalatable fruit to the conquerors. There will be peace such as is guaranteed by bayonets and prisons; but in the hearts of the Finns there will be feelings of hatred that will culminate in sorrow for Russians slain by the hands of assassins.

One of the most pleasant annual gatherings in Union county, is the meetings of the pioneers. This year they meet in this city on the 28th of this month and as La Grande is the most easily reached point in the valley this will certainly be one of the largest gatherings for a number of years.

The extension of our water system by the addition of ten thousand more feet of city water mains will be a benefit in many ways. It will increase the city revenue, furnish fire and domestic protection that heretofore has not been possible and will result in many new lawns and pretty homes that can only be made by the use of water.

Not being ready to attack the Japs in the rear and not being able to attack them in the front, General Kuropatkin continues to play his old losing game of both ends against the middle.

Notwithstanding the attitude of Governor Yates, the Illinois Hearst indorsement means something of a much larger Republican majority.
