BAD POLITICS.

The Oregon delegation to the Chicago convention, if correctly reported to, and published in the Oregonian of the morning of the 21 inst have shown very bad politics, and worse judgement.

With practically a universal sentiment among Republicans throughout the United States to let well enough alone and when to the policy and practice of protection, it is certainly bad politics for the Oregon delegation to put the Republicans of Oregon at variance with the mass of the Republicans in the nation on the tariff question, besides by so doing they falsify the sentiment of the Republicans of this state.

In view of the fact that there is now a Congressional Committee at work with instruction to determine what legislation is advisable to better the condition of the American merchant Marine it was very bad judgement on the part of one delegation to lead off on a forlorn hope against a ship subsidy or any other specifically proposed plan on our merchant Marine and this attempt to forestall the verdict of the commission, and this without proposing any plan. The bad judgement is shown by our delegation in placing themselves in the attitude of kickers at the general trend of the Re-

publican party and thus render the whole party in Oregon liable to the suspicion of being actuated, or at least controlled by some occult force that is not in harmony with the doctrines, policies, and national leaders of the Republican party of the nation.

The fact is the Republicans in Oregon are in hearty union with the great mass of Republicans throughout the nation, both in the tariff and the necessity of doing something to revise our merchant Marine.

THE CAMPAIGN.

The opening speech of Elihu Root at the Chicago Convention on June 21, on assuming the gavel as temporary chairman of the 13 Republican National Convention, was one of remarkable strength, but chiefly notable from the facts it contains and the boldness with which it appeals to the record of the Republican, as reasons for its continuance in control of national affairs.

The republican party is proud of its record, finding in the statistics, which show what has been done since 1860 convincing argument sustaining the wisdom of its policies, and ability of the leaders it has intrusted with their execution.

On that record the coming campaign will be fought and won. All the mud the Democrats can throw, and they are experts at dirt throwing, cannot obliterate the record or band the people to the prosperity that blesses them.
