BAD POLITICS.

With practically a universal sentiment among Republicans throughout the United States to let well enough alone and when to the policy and practice of protection, it is certainly bad politics for the Oregon deligation to put the Republicans of Oregon at varience with the mass of the Republicans in the nation on the tariff question, besides by so doing they falcify the sentiment of the Republicans of this state.
