SERMON ON THE MOUNT,

Mr. Williams closed his hour and forty two minutes speach at the St. Louis convention with the following peroration.

"Above all and in conclusion, good Democratic Administration will ponder and practice the simple precepts of Jefferson's first inagural address. It is the political sermon on the Mount tfor Democratic Republicans."

It would be a judiciously half hour spent by our Democratic readers if they would read Jefferson's first inaugural and compare its precepts with the fulsome declarations of Mr. Williams. The reader after reading Jefferson's inaugural will wonder what one of his precepts he would have the Democratic Administration ponder over and practice, without being sure of incuring the wrath of the D mocracy and especially that of Mr. Williams.

Mr. Williams gave Mr. Jeffersen great credit for inagurating territorial expansion. In his inagural Jefferson evidently had no thought of expansion for he used these words "Possessing a chosen country with room enough for our decendants to the thousandth and thousandth generation," with all these blessings what more is necessary to make us a happy and prosperous people." Jefferson used these words on March 4 1801. and before the Louisana purchas, and at a time when the area of the United States was but 827,-841 square miles. The present ar a is 3,025,600 square miles.

3-"The support of the state governments in all their rights, as the most competent administration for our domestic concerns and the surest bulwark against anti-republican tendencies."

4-"The preservation of the General Government in its whole constitutional vigor, as the sheet ancor of our peace at nome and safety abroad."

5-"A jealous care of the right of election by the people-a mild and safe correction of abuses which are lopped by the sword of revolution where peaceable emedies are not provided."

6-"Absolute acquiescence in he decesion of the majority, the vital principle of republics, from which is no appeal but to force, the vital principle and immediate parent of despotism."

7-"A well disciplined militia, our best reliance in peace and for the first moments war, till regulars may relieve them."

8-"The supremacy of the civil over the military authority." 9-"Economy in the public expenses that labor may be

lightly burthend." 10-"The honest payment of our debts and sacred preservaion of the public faith."

11-"Encouragement of agriculture, and of commerce as its andmaid." 12-" The diffusion of informs

and araingment of all abuses at the bar of public reason." 13-"Freedom of religon,"

14-"Freedom of the press, and freedom of person under the protection of the habeas corpus, and trial by juries impartialy selected."


