Notice To Water Consumers

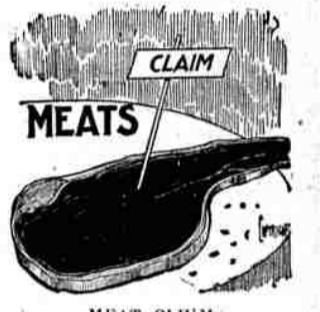
