A QUARLESOME PARTY.

The history of the Democratic party presents a series of internal feuds and quarrels beginning with the Democratic and bitter outbreak between Jefferson and Burr and continuing with more or less rancor to the present disagreement between Parker and Bryan. Aron Burr after serving with distinction as an officer in the colonial army during the revolutionary war, studied law and soon became acknowledged as one of the ablest lawyers in the United States. He was among the first anti-federalists and as a candidate for the presidency in 1800 he divided the electoral vote with Thomas Jefferson another anti-federalist each receiving 73 votes, which threw the election into the House of Representatives. After a bitter contest which lasted seven days Jefferson was elected president and Burr vice president. The heat engendered by this contest left a

bitter feud in the Democratic party that lasted as long as Burr lived. Burr turned his attention to the West, which was then deeply agitated because Spain held the mouth of the Mississippi and its only outlet for its produce. His political enemies charged him with the treasonable design of subjugating Texas and Mexico, and uniting them to the region west of the Alleghany mountains and thus form an independent government that would have full control of the Gulf of Mexico and the Mississippi river. His operations in the west so disturbed president Jefferson that on November 27, 1806 he issued a proclamation denouncing Burr's schemes as unlawful and warning all citizens to with draw therefrom. In addition to his order to with draw therefrom and quit under pain of being prosecuted if they persisted therein, he enjoined and required all officers, civil and military of the United States or Territories, and especially all governors and other executive authorities, all judges, justices, and other officers of the peace, all military of the army or navy of the United States, or officers of the militia, to be vigilant, each within his respective department and according to his functions, in searching out and bringing to condign punishment all persons engaged or concerned in such enterprise. Under this proclamation Burr was arrested in Alabama three months after its issuance taken to Richmond Virginia where he was tried, and after one of the most remarkable jury trials in the United States, was acquitted, by Jefferson being unable to prove his charges. The Burr trial is now regarded by most people as the outcome of the quarrel between him and Jefferson. Old citizens will remember the unpleasant relatives between Stephen A. Douglass and his party leaders that resulted in two Democratic tickets in 1860. In Oregon there was the O. C. Pratt Democracy fighting the Salem wing, this was followed by the very bitter contest between the Lane Democracy and the Bush faction. The Grover Democracy had trouble with another element of the party which was not eliminated when the Penneyer party got into power. The Bryan and Parker trouble is just now producing or at least bring into notice much unpleasantness in the Democratic ranks.

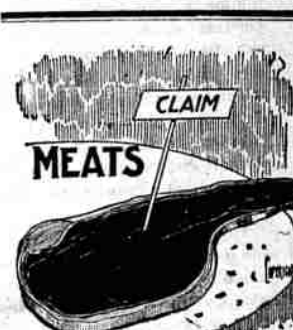
