LABORERS IN THE UNITED STATES

A little time spent in going over the figures of the United States census for 1900, would be well spent by those economic labor agitators who seem to believe that numerically the laboring people are in a large majority in the United States.

It is true that more than one-half of the people in the United States, about 58 per cent, do follow some gainful occupation for a living but among these are owners of their own shops, or professional men etc.

In 1900 there were 21,329,819 males of voting age in the United States. In 1900 there was a total of 18,821,000 males ten years old and over engaged in some gainful occupation, but this number includes 7,887,000 agriculturalists and 482,000 professionals.

As neither the agriculturalists nor the professionalists affiliate with organized labor in the present attitude of the labor question, both should be deducted from the above total, and we have but 10,934,000 including the miners, that really ought to be considered as laborers.

While the above figures give the outside rating strength of the affiliated members at nine million, Mr. Mitchell, the head man of organized labor in the United States, gave a slight hint ago, the aggregate membership of organized labor at 2,000,000 or less than one quarter of the men working in the affiliated vocations and not one tenth as many as the voters in the United States.

In addition to burglaries innumerable, the boys have confessed to the commission of two murders.

and the education so easily acquired on the right side of a big city. There is the solution of the Chicago case in the murders and of the burglaries and murders committed in the latest juvenile quarter. In their case it is shown that an impulsive surrender of personal control was made and controlled.

It appears that whether the boys attended school or followed their own ways will be all one to the parents. Whether they were home at a reasonable hour or whether they remained the streets was all one to the parents who are now bitterly repeating their course when it is too late.

The establishment of juvenile courts is a long step in the right direction and an additional number of trained officers would be another, with a uniform well added. After a fixed hour boys have no business on the streets unaccompanied by parents or officers in the place of parents.

Chicago is teaching the lesson—juvenile officers would have less to do and the penitentiaries would not have so many alumni graduated from the streets—Chicago and Tribune.
