Let us examine the record and see how thinka have been in years gone by when Clevelan Demorratic; During the four years or Clevelanis second term there were 57,412 commercial failures in the United States with failures in the United lates with an aggsegate of liabilities a
mounting to $\$ 919,080,439$, the greatest number of failures was during the first year of Cleveland's term with 15,242 failures
with lisbilities at $\$ 346,779,889$ with lisbilities at $\$ 346,779,888$ -
During the four year- of $\mathrm{Re}-$ publican rule, from 1903 back, there were 45,460 commercial failures with lisbilities aggregat ing $524,508,003$.
By compariug the commercial failares that oceured in Cleveland's second administration with the failures that occured during the four years of Repub lican rule ending June 301903 the last year of, which the Obser ver bas the offioial record, it wil be seen that the record show that in Cleveland's second sidministration there were 11,952 more failures than in the four years of Republican rule, and that the liabilities of the failing deministration exceeded those in the seid four years of Bepub liean rule by $\$ 369,552,436$ lican rule by $\$ 369,552,486$.
