# RUSSIA NOW ANGRY

St. Petersburg, Sept. 22.—Irritation regarding Great Britain's course in Tibet is displayed by the Novoye Vremya's remarks regarding the statement made in the house of commons by Broderick secretary of state for India, that the best way of preserving peace is to be prepared for war and England's army in the Indian frontier is ready.  
Novoye Vremya declares the majority of Great Britain's international success was won not by fighting but by bluffing.  
The article concludes: "This sort of diplomatic intimation cannot continue indefinitely. In reply to Broderick's words we can quickly and confidently say we are ready too."
