CONTRACT LET FOR THE ALICEL WELL

To Be Sunk 1000 Feet--McConnell Well is now Down 514 Feet--900 Feet More Casing Ordered

Senator A McDonald was in the city yesterday afternoon and closed a contract with Mr Hunt for the sinking of the artesian well for the company organized several months ago at Alicel.

This contract provides for sinking a well 1000 feet deep. Mr Hunt is an expert well digger from California brought here by Mr Thomas McConnell and is now engaged in sinking his well eight miles east of this city.

The McConnell well is now down to a depth of 514 feet and operations have suspended until the arrival of 900 feet more of casing which has been ordered and will arrive within a few days.

The exact location where the Alicel well will be driven has not yet been decided upon and will not until bids have been received by the farmer who will give the largest amount for a flowing well. The amount so received will go towards the expense of the experiment.

In speaking with one of the stockholders in the company, he stated that if a good flow of water could be secured at an expense of about \$1000 here would soon be many such wells on the Sandridge.
