## BEEF CATTLE FOR PORTLAND

Eight Carloads Shipped From Haines in One Day--Stock Conditions in That Section

G. W. Thomas, one of the most extensive cattle dealers in Eastern Oregon, was in town a few days last week. Mr. Thomas yesterday drove to North Portland eight car loads of fine beef cattle, which he has been feeding in this vicinity and which he sold to Kiddle Bros. of La Grande. From North Powder they will be shipped to the Portland market. Mr. Thomas

while here also bought 150 head of beef cattle which he will feed here until in condition for the market. Monday he will receive at Baker City about 100 head which he purchased on Burnt River. Mr. Thomas states that the stock interests of this section have nothing to fear from a hard winter. There is plenty of feed in the country to keep all the stock in good condition. The stockmen who suffered loss through shortage last winter are not going to be caught again. Good beef cattle are very scarce at present, and most of the available stock has been bought up. What remains will require considerable feeding before ready for market. —Haines Record.

### Taking the Hint

The indications are that the anti-liquor movement which went against prohibition that the saloons will be conducted with some semblance of decency hereafter. Mayor Taylor of Athena has issued a notice to the effect that he will enforce the state law against gambling in any form; the permitting of minors; to later in saloons; the sale of intoxicating liquor to minors; the running of disorderly houses and all other forms of vice. For a town like Athena this is a long step forward in the interest of reform. The local opinion law is a kind of a Damocles sword and will have the effect of lessening vice even in precincts that don't believe in prohibition. —Milton Eagle.
