World's Fair Buildings Sold

St. Louis, Dec. 6.—It was stated today that a contract for the sale of the 11 big exhibit palaces, stock barns, festival hall, the state pavilions, aerodrome, bank, intramural railway, hospital, press building, police and fire stations, with other world's fair structures, that cost \$15,000,000, will be signed this week with a Chicago packing company for \$380,000. Everything except the rolling stock of the intramural railway, which has been sold separately, the state, foreign and pike buildings, are included in the deal.

PROHIBITION SWEEPING TEXAS

Austin, Texas, Dec. 6.—Prohibition is having a rapid spread in Texas. According to the annual report of the state revenue agent just issued, total prohibition prevails in 100 of 218 counties of the state, and partial prohibition is in effect in 57 additional counties. In nearly all of the counties in western Texas, where cattle interests are situated, the sale of liquor is prohibited by local option law.
