ORDINANCE NO. 300 Series 1904

An Ordinance granting to the La-Grande Water Storage Company (a private corporation) and its successors, nd assigns, the right and privilege. for a period of thirty years, to erect and maintain poies, and other apparstus, and to place thereupon wires, enductors and other appliances and to lay under ground such wires and appliances for the transmission of electricity and electric currents and power for operating and furnishing setric lights, telephones, electric motore and other electric power, in over and under the streets, alleys, shoroughfares and public highways. within the City of La Grande, Union right and privilege of so operating now in force or which may be enforce and furnishing electric lights, telephones, electric motors and electric power within said City.

Section 1:-The City of La Grande sereby grants to the La Grande Water Storage Company, its succee sors and assigns, the right and priviavenues, thoroughfares and public electricity and electric currents for electric lights, telephone system. elsetric power and other lawfol uses therewith connected, such wires or conductors as may be strung or fixed upon poles and other fixtures to be highway, and not less than thirty feet at any other place within the city (except in houses, buildings, stations and storages) or such wires and appliances may, at the option of the grantee of this franchise, its successors and assigns be laid under ground in piper, conduits and such other ap

paratus to be used as may be necessary and proper to operate and

Section 2:- It shall be lawful for the La Grande Water Storage Company, casors and ass any and all-needful and proper excava-tions in any of the streets, alleys, avenues, thoroughfares and public biguways within the City of La Grande for the purposes of erecting and main-taining poles or other supports for said wires or other conductors or for the repairing of the same or for the purpose of laying down, maintaining and operating said wires, apparatus other conductors and storage statio under ground and for repairing the same, said work to be done in com pliance with the necessary rules, reg-Urunty, Oregon and to exercise the dere and laws of said city which are during the continuance of this franchise, passes or sdopted from time to time by the said City of La Grande, and the said work shall be done in a proper and safe manner and to the satisfaction of said City.
