STATE COURT HOUSE

First Took Records and Next Night Took the Building.

Aberdeen, S D Dec 30—A crowd of men went from Selby to Bangor Tuesday night and by force carried off the county records, leaving word they would return the next night for the county house itself, and kept their promise. The building has been torn down, loaded on wagons, hauled to Selby in sections and today is being rebuilt. Although the action of the Selby men aroused bitter feeling, the residents of Bangor made no resistance.

Killed Before Divorce

San Francisco Dec 30—Edward Bruce Metcalf, a traveling photographer or was shot to death in his room at a lodging house in this city at an early hour this morning by a man identified by the victim's wife as Edward Keeley with whom Mrs Metcalf has been friendly.

The Metcalfe came here a few weeks ago from Auburn Cal. Quarrels said to have been caused by Keeley's friendliness for his friend's wife, resulted in Mrs Metcalf applying for a divorce some time since. This case was to have been decided today.

The only witness to the murder was Mrs Metcalf who states that she saw Keeley emerge from her husband's room a few minutes after the shot was fired run to the hallway, hence downstairs out on to the street, making good his escape.

What the quarrel was about the wife does not know nor can she give a reason why Keeley should have visited her husband at that hour in the morning. There are so many strange circumstances regarding the affair that Mrs Metcalf is under suspicion herself.
