## TO PRACTICE OSTEOPATHY

Senator Brownell Introduces a Bill Licensing the Profession

senate bill No 120, introduced by Senator Brownell, licensing graduated osteopaths in the state of Oregon;

A bill for an act to regulate the pratice of osteopathy in the state of Oregon, and to provide for a state board of osteopathic examiners, and to \_license esteopaths to practice in this state, and punish persons violating the provisions of this act.

Be it enacted by the legislative assembly of the state of Oregon, be it enacted by the people of the state of

ticing esteopathy [in this state shall of this act and holding a diploma from possess the qualifactions required by a legally authorized college of osteopa-

Sec 2. The Governor of the state shall appoint a board of examiners as soon as possible after the passage of this act, to be known as the state board of osteopathic examiners This board shall consist of five [5] individual examination in the followqualified practicing resident osteopaths each of whom shall be a graduate of a legally authorized college of osteopathy, Each member of said board shall serve thereon for a term of two years and until his successor is appointed, except in case of the first board, on which two [2] members shall serve for two [2] years and three [3] years, as specified in their appointment, In case of a vacency by death or otherwise, there shall be appointed in like manner a person to serve through such unexpired :term.

Sec 3. Said board of ostepathic examiners shall elect a president 'secretary and treasurer, and shall have a common seal, and its president and secretary shall have power to adminisier oaths Said board shall shold meetings for examination at the state capitol at such other place as the board may select, on the tnird Friday of March and September of each year of March and September of each year and such other meetings as may be deemed necessary, each session therefore, of not to exceed two days, and shall lasue a certificate of qualification to all applicants having a diploma, and Newlin Drug Co

who shall pass the required examinations as provided by section four [4] of this act, said certificate shall be signed by the passident and secretary of said board, and attested by its seal, and shall be conclusive as to the rights of the lawful holder of the same to practice osteopathy in this state, Said board shall keep a record of all Following are the chief sections of its proceeding and also a register of of asteopathy, and of the name and location of the college of osteopathy from which said applicant holds a diploms, and shall keep a register which shall show the names of all ap-plicants licensed or that are rejected under this act

> Sec 4 It shall be unlawful for any person to practice esteopathy in this state without a license from said board All persons practicing cateopathy within this state prior to the passage of this act and holding a diploma from thy, of good repute, may be licensed to practice osteopathy in this state by submitting to said board of osteopathic examiners such a diploma, and satisfying such board that they are the legal holders thereof, and by undergoing an ing branches, to-wit: Anatomy, phy-stology, chemistry, histology, pathology, gyneology, obsteterics and theory and practice of osteopathy, and such other branches as the board shall deem advisable.

> Sec 5 The license provided for by this act shall not authorize the holder thereof to give or prescribe drugs for internal use nor to perform major surgery.
