# Proposed Amendments to the City Charter

The bill introduced in the legislature amending the charter of our city has passed the senate and will undoubtedly pass the house. We understand these amendments were made by a committee of the Commercial club and a committee from the council. The amendments provide for the enlargement of the city limits on the north and east, for dividing the city into four wards instead of three, this will increase the number of council-

men from six to eight, also makes a new provision for the collection of the road taxes and covers what defect if any there may be in the wording of the present charter with reference to the building of wooden buildings within the fire limits. This we have been told is all the changes made and as there is no emergency clause it will not go into effect in time to be effective for the coming city election.

## Grip Is "Catching"

Dr. Woods Hutchinson, secretary of the state board of health, in speaking of the epidemic of the grip now raging in Portland says to the Oregon Daily Journal:

"The best means of protection is to avoid exposure to a previous case. Nine-tenths of what we call "colds" do not come from the weather conditions. They are the result of direct infection. A person with grip should be isolated in a warm room and remain very quiet—not go out of doors and defy the disease. The best way to prevent a cold is to have the bed-room well ventilated and use plenty of cold water on the skin. The theater, hotel and the Pullman sleeper are the most common means of the spreading of the disease.

Montpelier, Vt. Feb 1 — Governor Bell this afternoon listened to an appeal for a reprieve for Mrs. Mary Rogers who is under sentence to hang for the murder of her husband.
