What are the actual facts with
Ward to the benefits that bave corved to the farmers of the United States fron the free dis Uribution of seeds to them the eneral governmert? The eneral govera wia erver answers this quastion b axtracts from a letter frum James Wison Secretary of Agri alture to he Ho e S Chandier M. C. from Miss, dated Jan 23 1905 and published in the Con gressi
1905.
"The records show that the de partment of Agriculture has bee helpful in the introdaction o many of the crops that are at present considered the most valuable in the United States Among these crops may be mentioned the Fultz and other varielies of wheat; Chinese Sor gum. introduced in the early sixties at a cost of about $\$ 2,00$
and now worth easily man millions annually to the country the cow pea, without which the lons for the improvement of his land; the Kaffir corn, the introland; the Kaffir corn, the intro-
duction of which cost the Depart duction of which cost the Depari-
ment not wore than $\$ 5,000$ and of which the aunual value at present is eatimsted at about $\$ 20,600,000$; Macaroni wheat, on which during the last three
years, we have expended about years, we have expended about
$\$ 10.000$ and which has enabled the farmers of the arid west grow crops worth from $\$ 6,000$, 000 to $\$ 7,000,000$ on lands on which they could not grow the ordinary varieties; Japanese rice, which has been a large factor in the phenominal growth of the rice induatry in Texas and Louisiana, the ncreage devoted to which has ivereased from 210 , 396 acres in 1898 to a total 610,700 acres in 1904, raising the value of the land froming the value of the hand from between a dollar to from thinty a half per acre lo from thirly five to fifty dollars per acre, and the output has been increase from $115,000,000$ pounds in
1898 to $650,000,000$ pounds in 1898 to
$1904 . "$
From the data given in the
lotter it is shown that the cost o all the seed and plant introduc-
culture from 1852 to 1905 foots up $84,447,402$. 08 and the estimatof the varieties introduced by the Agricultural Department is far in excess of $\$ 100,000,000$. These figares show that the expenditure of public money for seeds and plants for free distribution among the farmere has met, in the past.
