The Largest Ever

Wednesday afternoon there was taken out of Elgin a car of lumber that contained 68,198 board feet. According to The Lumberman, a leading and reliable trade paper, this was the largest carload of lumber ever loaded and shipped in the United States. Its magnitude exceeded the stated record by a little more than 7000 feet. The car was loaded by the G. M. & S. Co. of this city, and was billed to Morris & Merrill of Salt Lake City, for delivery at Calientes Nevada. The shipment was entirely of yellow pine, and Foreman W. C. Rider estimates that the load would weigh about 116,000 pounds.—Elgin Recorder

Northwest News

Northport Wash. will in a few weeks vote upon a proposition to install a municipal lightning plant.

Whitman county is expected to put up \$250,000 for the Spokane & Inland electric railroad. Of this amount Colfax is scheduled for \$50,000.

Fire in the New York store at North Yakima did damage amounting to over \$1000 to the stock. The building was not much injured.

The new gas plant at Lewiston will be put in operation March 12. There are four miles of main down now and more will be laid next summer.

The abandoned land comprised in the old Fort Sherman military reservation will be sold at public auction at Coeur d'Alene city June 6 next.

Fairfield, Wash. incorporated. The first official act of the first meeting of the council, following the appointment of a clerk, was to grant a saloon license.

The Whiskey Galop Mining Company, near Lewiston, is being sued by its miners for \$15,000 wages due and the appointment of a receiver to take charge of its affairs is looked for.

All the labor unions of Spokane, except the porters and bartenders will be represented in a Union meeting on March 12 to recognize the Central Labor Assembly and settle old differences.

Claude O Basset of Spokane, a cadet at Annapolis is considered one of the best fencers in America. He is a freshman at the academy, but belongs in a team of old and expert swordsmen.
