CLAIMS HE WILL CONVICT

[Scripps News Association]
Washington, March 13.—It is announced that the cases against Senator Mitchell and Representative Hermann of Oregon for their alleged complicity in the public land frauds will be brought to trial in Portland early in June. Attorney Haney, who secured the indictments, left for Oregon Saturday after a conference with President Roosevelt and Secretary of the Interior Hitchcock. The Attorney General asserts that he expects to secure several new indictments against prominent men on the coast. Secretary Hitchcock assured the President of his ability to obtain convictions in the cases now pending.
