LAND FRAUDS IN OREGON

Secretary Hitchcock of the Department of the Interior gave out a statement on last Saturday showing that since the investigations of the alleged land frauds in Oregon by that Department that sixty eight indictments have been found by the United States Grand Jury, six convictions have been rendered by trial juries. The other sixty two cases will be tried as soon as the United States court can reach them, which will most probably be able to commence on them about the first of April next. Of the indictments, fifty two are for conspiracy to defraud the government out of land, and the others for the various crimes of perjury, subordination of perjury and obstructing the administration of justice.

When a list of the indicted are read it would seem that the cup of shame that is being presented to Oregon is full, for the list includes one United States Senator from Oregon and both our members of the House of Representatives, eight attorneys who have held prominent positions, one state and two ex-state Senators, an ex-United States Assistant Attorney and his deputy, an ex-Surveyor General and deputy, several deputy surveyors, examiners of surveys, one United States Commissioner of the United States General Land Office, two ex-Commissioners of the United States District Court for Oregon and a number of land and timber dealers and homesteaders.

Mrs. Chadwick has been convicted on seven counts. As it is expressed in the vernacular, that should hold her for awhile, since she is subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000 on each count and imprisonment not exceeding two years.—Idaho Statesman.
