### TRANSPORTATION COST

While the people are very properly giving much thought to what it is costing them to use the great railroad lines in the country, it will be wise on their part to give some serious consideration to what it is costing to use the common roads that lead from their farms to the railroad stations. It would be a good idea for every farmer to consult his actual outlays and find out definitely what it is costing him to move a ton of freight from his farm to the railroad station where the products of his farm begin their journey to market.

The Hon. W D Vandiver of Ohio in a speech in Congress published in the Congressional Record of March 8, 1905, advocating national aid in building common roads said: "It costs the American farmer an average of twenty five cents per mile to transport a ton of produce from the field to the railroad station. It only costs eight cents in Europe. The difference is in the character of the roads."
