\$8,000 FOR EXHIBIT

The County Court of Jackson County, Oregon has appropriated \$8,000 for placing an exhibit of the products of that County at the Lewis and Clark Fair. The Court selected the orchardist, John V Olwell of Medford to superintend the exhibit. With a real live man like Olwell in charge, Jackson county will doubtless make a splendid showing.
