It is predicted that the seedless apple will revolutionize the apple industry like the seedless orange did a few years ago.

It is expected that two more important transfers in Grande Ronde mines will take place within the next two weeks.

The fishing season opens April 1, and owing to the fact of light snow in the mountains, the mountain streams will afford good fishing earlier than usual.

The city marshal should enforce the house, number ordinance. There is a penalty for non-compliance. One or two fines would cause a stampede in the right direction.

A strict enforcement of the bicycle ordinance may result in the passage of a more liberal ordinance, whereby only the business streets may be retained in the prohibited district.

Now that the Navy Department has ordered the Colorado to Venezuelan waters, President Castro may recollect what happened to Chief Executives in the other Colorado.
