NEW BANK AT NORTH POWDER

Salem Ore, April 17—Seventeen domestic corporations filed papers with the Secretary of State this week, among them being the Farmers' and Merchants State Bank, with principal office at North Powder, Ore. The capital stock is \$25,000, and the incorporators H O Gorham, N B Bowman, B M Mann, W J Candler and Chris Johnson.
