DR BANCROFT TELLS HIS STORY

Last evening Dr T D Bancroft, the philanthropist, filled the pulpit at the Baptist church, and for more than an hour held his audience in close attention to his discourse. In the beginning he asked the choir to make part of his audience, and, in doing so paid them some well turned compliments. After this he told in an inimitable manner of his first entrance into the realm of religion. He said that the reading of good books leads to doing good, and leads to religion. That when a person has religion, he can not keep from doing good. The descriptions of his first attempts at propagating the laws of Christ and in undertaking christian work, were filled with rare flashes of wit and interspersed with many bits of dry humor. Not only this, but the pathos, the suffering and the need of his work in assisting poor children, was graphically described and in forcible language. After describing his earlier work, he then told of the work he has on hand, that which he is making the life work of a good man who has already begun to descend the shady side of the hill of life. In pathetic terms he told of his first discovery of the conditions of the poor consumptives in Colorado, his investigation into the matter, and his final determination to build a free home for those who were unable to support themselves, give them the benefit of the health-giving climate, and bring them back to health. It is a great work, and deserves the assistance and commendation of all christian people.
