New, York, May 10—A certificate of incorporation of the Carnegie foundation, a membership corporation to manage the fund of \$10,000,000 given by Andrew Carnegie for pensions for teachers in universities, colleges and technical schools in the United States, Canada and Newfoundland, was filed in the county clerk's office today. The trustees named by Mr Carnegie and announced by Mr Frank A Vauderly on April 27, are named as directors until the first annual meeting of the membership corporation.
