With the party wearing some distinguishing mark to denote who they were and with a drum corps to head the procession to and from the different places they would attract a great deal of attention.

With a hundred lusty lungs singing from "the land of fruit, grain, hay and sunshine" the sleepy old towns on the coast would be wakened up.—Boise News.

The keenest resentment is manifest by the court and army officials to whom the matter is known.
