## A Beautiful Lecture

It is seldom that a La Grande audience has had the opportunity of hearing a discourse so full of force, so pleasing, and with all so instructive, as that which was delivered last evening at the Presbyterian church by Preston W Search, the "giant lecturer."

His style of delivery is inimitable and attractive, while his enunciation is pure and true. With gestures he is pleasing, using them effectively in impressing strong points upon the audience. In drawing word pictures he has few equals and his descriptions of places and scenes are clear cut and delightful. His subject last evening was "Music in the Fatherland," and the lecture itself was music from beginning to end. In enthusiastic terms he painted a word picture of the German family life, of its simplicity, sweetness, wholesomeness and restfulness. He told of the love of music in that country; how each home had the very

best music—the music of the old masters; how the stage was conducted in the Fatherland, where an actor or actress, that is a singer, was required to be as circumspect and upright as a teacher or a pastor in this country.

He told of how the people of that country strove to keep out all such music as the so-called "rag time," and how it was made possible for the peasant class to hear the music of the best masters, played by master hands, at a very small price. But the most beautiful and soul stirring part of the entire lecture was his description of Tannhauser and Elizabeth; of the love of the pure, immaculate Elizabeth for the often tempted and yielding master Tannhauser of the storms that beset him; and of his final saving and redemption through the love of a pure woman and noble friend. During this description, the audience were held spell bound, and when Mr Robert Fakin, Jr., sat at the piano and played a selection of "the music of the Fatherland," the climax was reached.

The Last of the Search Lectures tonight is "A Winter in Switzerland." This promises to be an exceedingly attractive lecture, full of fun, sublimity, stirring adventure, amusing incidents and mountain climbing. Professor Search spent a winter in the high Alps and proposes to take his audience there also. The magic of high art in dramatic storytelling will be best seen and felt in this lecture of tonight.
