HUNT MAY TRY

LAND FRAUD CASE

Attorney General Moody had a conference Saturday with the president regarding the successor to Charles B. Bellinger, United States district judge for the district of Oregon, who died last night. Judge Bellinger was to have tried the case of Senator John H. Mitchell and others indicted for conspiracy to defraud the United States in certain land cases. No decision has yet been reached as to who will be appointed as Judge Bellinger's successor. The situation in Oregon is peculiar. One senator and both representatives are under indictment. They cannot be consulted, of course, as to the appointment.

In view of the condition which exists, it is quite probable that Judge William H. Hunt of the district of Montana will be designated to try the land fraud cases. It may be some time before the permanent successor to Judge Bellinger is named.

FRANCE AGAIN

MAKES DENIAL

Paris, May 15.—The French Government has issued another denial of the allegations made by the Japanese Government to the effect that the Russian fleet lingered too long either in Kamran bay or Honkohe bay. The declaration that the fleet of Rojstevsky left the bays on May 8th, and have since remained away from French waters, is still repeated.
