## FIRST OPEN RACE ACROSS ATLANTIC

(By Scripps News Association)  
Navesink Highland, May 16.—The Kaiser's cup contest for the first open trans Atlantic yacht race ever sailed will start from the Sandy Hook light ship at two fifteen this afternoon. Eleven yachts will be started in the three thousand mile contest, which will end on the rocky ledges of Lizard, off the coast of England. A nasty, wet fog, like a blanket, hung over the sea this morning, and an early breeze out of the southeast died away, and there is a practical calm. The committee in charge will send the yachts away unless in dread of a flat calm which will make steering way impossible.

## Two Specials Coming
