Tax Meeting

The meeting held in the Commercial Club Saturday afternoon, to continue the discussion of the assessment of the property of this county at its actual cash value, was well attended. The only objection to this policy was the fear that in the future the legislature might see fit to change the present system of arranging for the state tax, and Union county's proportion might be higher than under present conditions. But inasmuch as the last legislature extended the present system until 1910, there does not seem to be any great cause for alarm. The assessor stated that at the present time just about one half of the county had been assessed and the remaining portion would be continued in a like manner.

The meeting however passed a resolution expressing their sentiment that the values as based on last year's assessment would represent the present true cash value at this time.

As no mention was made in any wise of referring to the committee appointed at last Saturday's meeting, we presume this will settle the matter and the assessment will proceed along the line as originally outlined, and when the totals are made known, it is quite probable that the assessment will be in excess of \$13,000,000 as against \$1,000,000 last year, and instead of a tax levy of about 34 mills, it will be about 13.
