Pendleton May 19—Complaint has reached Deputy Game and Fish Warden, Joe Nolf that some elk have been killed in Southern Union county, near North Powder, and the matter is being investigated. It is forbidden by law to kill elk in Oregon under any circumstances, and the penalty for doing so is a heavy fine or imprisonment.

New Sugar Plants

Salt Lake May 19—General Manager T R Cutler of the Utah & Idaho sugar companies has returned from a visit to the Payette and Boise valley districts in Idaho, where the new company to be known as the Western Idaho Sugar company will build two factories next year.

For the location of the Payette plant land has been bought two miles south of Payette on the Oregon Short Line. The site of the Nampa plant has not been definitely fixed. Mr Cutler stated that it will be necessary to incorporate the company about June 1, with a capital of two million dollars instead of a million and a half, owing to the decision to build larger plants than had been originally contemplated.

Springs Leased

Dr C H Bingham has leased his popular Bingham Springs resort to M E Foley, formerly of the Rochester hotel in Tacoma, an experienced summer resort hotel man who will greatly improve the hotel and make it the leading resort in Umatilla county.

Plague At Harbin

London, May 19—According to a correspondent at Tokio of the Daily Telegraph a severe epidemic of plague has broken out at Harbin and the deaths resulting there from its average 300 daily.
