Marshall Ore June 10—James Castello, a pioneer of Coos county whose home was at Bandon, and William Harris, a young man who lived at Port Orford, were drowned by the wrecking of a gasoline launch yesterday while going to the deep sea fishing grounds off the mouth of the Coquille river.

As the launch was crossing the Coquille bar heavy seas apparently disabled the engine and carried the frail craft on the rocks of the south jetty. The lifesaving crew endeavored to reach the unfortunates, but before they could get to the place, the launch had been ground to pieces and Castello beaten to death on the rocks. Harris' body was not found.
