WILL FORTIFY CHINESE PORT

Berlin June 14—An Imperial order to fortify Kiao Chou bay, the German concession in the southern part of the Shantung peninsula, has been issued. The work will be done under the supervision of the governor of the protectorate. Rear Admiral Fuppel and five engineer fortification officers were detailed for this purpose. The extent of the fortifications and the amount to be spent on them are facts which have not been disclosed. As Kiao Chou is Germany's only station in the far eastern waters, the navy department has desired since its acquisition to make it a secure base for German warships. The fortification of Kiao Chou at this time, it is said, need not be construed as preparing for its defense against any particular power, but only as a precautionary measure too long neglected.

Going To The Fair

William H Packwood, a pioneer of 1849 and one of the few surviving members of the constitutional convention which met at Salem in 1857, will attend and celebrate the Pioneers' Day at the Lewis and Clark Fair, which is scheduled for the 16th. With Mrs Packwood he left Baker City on the early train this morning and will be one of the most interesting characters at the fair. He was accompanied by Mr. Williams, Ex-Governor L F Grover, and Judge R P Boise are three other living signers of the Oregon Constitution.—Baker Democrat.

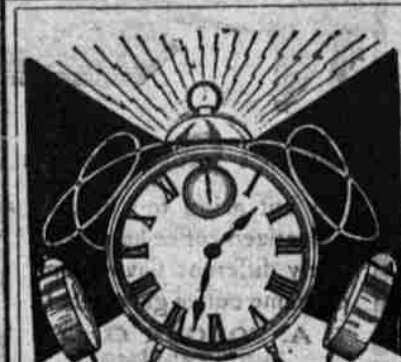
