The Eastern Oregon Normal school at Weston will not be closed. The board of regents at a meeting held in Pendleton decided to take definite steps to secure means by which the institution will be sustained during the coming school even though the state refuses to appropriate a dollar towards its maintenance.

Horse Sales

Horse buyers have been making purchases in the southeastern portion of the county during the past few weeks and recent sales are: W W Brown, 400 head; W C Jones, 58 head; Joe Street 20 head and O T Lillard 208 head of horses and mules. Most of the stock was purchased by Woodruff of Walla Walla and a buyer from Klamath Falls at a price of \$60 and \$65 for horses and \$35 for mules.—Crocket County Journal.

EIGHTEEN KILLED IN RAILWAY WRECK

Baltimore, June 19.—Eighteen persons are known to have been killed and a score or more injured Saturday night in a train wreck on the Western Maryland railroad about a quarter of a mile from Pataasco, a small station between Westminster and Pinksburg. Passenger train No 5, westbound, was running at a very high rate of speed when at the point named it crashed into a double header freight running east. All three of the engines were reduced to scrap iron, two express and baggage cars smashed and a number of the freight cars splintered. The passenger coaches sustained little injury and almost without exception their occupants escaped, with nothing worse than a bad shaking up. The fatalities occurred among the crews of the engines and the workmen employed by the railroad. The workmen were on their way to their homes in small towns along the Western Maryland to spend Sunday Not being regular passengers, they had boarded the baggage car and engine. Those in the baggage cars were badly mangled, and the crews of all three engines were killed outright.

Make a Million

Chicago, June 19.—Profits of \$1,350,000 in three years are said to have been made by the Continental Finance company and an allied concern known as the Continental Finance company, for both of which concerns the Western Trust & Savings bank has been appointed receiver under a bill filed in the circuit court.

The plan of the operation of the concerns was for the Continental Finance company to send out circulars offering to receive deposits of \$5 per month for 10 years, at which time it promised that the depositor's principal and interest \$72 and the depositor's share of the profits would be \$200, totaling just \$1000.

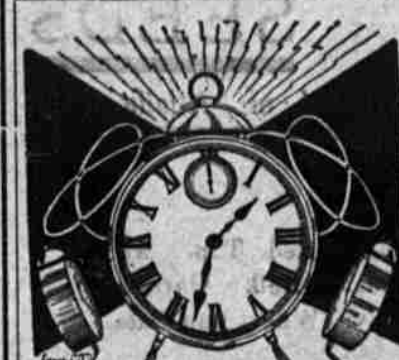
