Grows Rubber Plants

Santa Rosa, Cal., June 20.—The rubber seeds recently planted by Luther Burbank at his home in this city are coming up nicely, and experiments with these plants are now actively under way. The seeds which have sprouted were sent to the wonder worker from Colorado, and in response to many appeals from that state Burbank has consented to experiment with them and try to develop their commercial value. During the past week Burbank has received corres-pondence from South America, asking him to undertake experiments with a new rubber plant discovered there. He consented to handle the South American plants along with those from Colorado, and will receive a ship-ment of plants and seeds from that country in the near future.

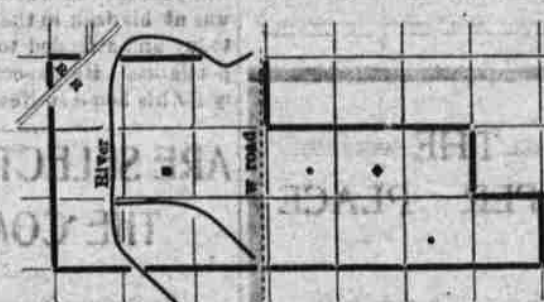

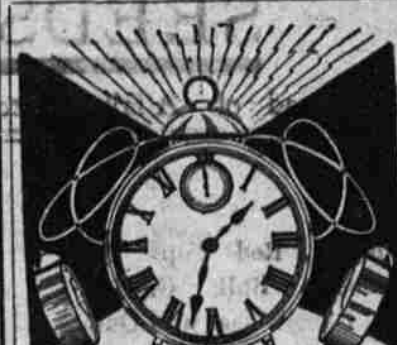
