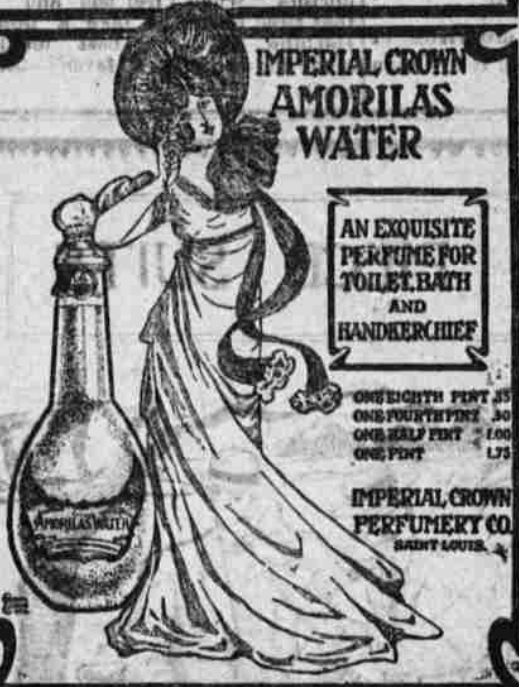

## THE OIL KING GIVES A MILLION

New Haven Conn. June 28—President Hadley of Yale announced at the alumni dinner this afternoon that a gift of \$1,000,000 had been recently made by John D. Rockefeller. President Hadley also said that \$2,000,000 in all have been given to the university within a comparatively recent time, the other million being subscribed by graduates in sums varying from \$50,000 to \$250,000. The names of the latter donors were not made public.

President Hadley said that "the only condition of any kind underlying Mr. Rockefeller's gift is that the money is to be invested in income producing securities and preserved inviolate as endowment for the institution the annual income only to be used for current expenses."

He added that these two millions already subscribed were to be considered merely the beginning of an endowment fund which must at least be doubled in the next year if Yale is to maintain her position in the educational world. The announcement of the gifts was received with loud cheers.

## Pope Newspaper

The pope is to become the publisher of a newspaper. The publication will take the form of a weekly gazette and will be issued in September. It will be printed by the Vatican press and is to be the sole official organ of the holy see. The object is to prevent the spreading of inaccurate reports and to avoid the now common occurrence whereby private and imprudent expressions of opinion by various clerical or semi-clerical journals compromise the holy see.—American Press.

## STEVE WALLACE VERY WEALTHY

Sam Dorracoe, well known here, returned from a tour of inspection of the Moose Mountain country in British Columbia this morning and while there met Steve Wallace, who was grown in this valley and who left for foreign lands on rather short notice who is now mayor of the city of Fernie and is said to be easily worth \$100,000, having a monthly income from rentals of \$1200. He owns the leading hotel and other property, and stated that he thought possible he would visit Grande Ronde Valley this summer.

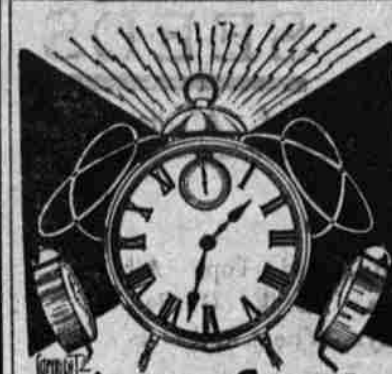
