**DROWNED BY  
PLAYMATES**

New York, July 3.—Jealousy engendered in the hearts of his playmates by the pretty clothes his father had given him for being promoted in school led to the death today of 10 year old Charles Feingold and the arrest of 8 year old John Quirk on a charge of being one of the group of boys who threw Charles into the river.

When Charles appeared in his new suit, shoes and cap, the boys with whom he played took exception to his appearance. They lured him to the dock at the foot of West Nineteenth street and there they told him he would have to take off his clothes, as they intended to sell them and spend the money.

The little fellow revolted, and as he raised his fists to fight, the boys began to crowd around him and shove him toward the end of the dock. Suddenly, with a cry of fright, he was pushed from the dock and landed head first in the river. Unable to swim a stroke, he drowned.

**Norwegians Appeal**

Chicago, July 3.—The petition which has been forwarded to President Roosevelt signed by nearly 30,000 Norwegians residing in or near Chicago, asking the recognition of the new government of Norway quotes the resolutions as adopted by the Norwegian storting on June 7, and then says that, "we, citizens of the United States, of Norwegian birth and blood, do earnestly hope and do respectfully petition that you will at the earliest opportunity signify your recognition of the new government of Norway, so created by the sovereign will of the Norwegian people as expressed by the unanimous action of their representatives in the storting assembled."

**Fund For Defense**

Stockholm, July 3.—Motions were introduced in both chambers of the riksdag Saturday placing \$25,000,000 at the disposal of the government to enable it to take such measures which it may deem necessary in the present crisis.
