The Petition of Dr C M Ramdell asking for a chance of location in a certain county road, was continued for the term

In the matter of the proposed road petitioned for by B E Harrell, it was ordered that Arthur Curtis, B Logsdon, and B B Morelock constituting the Board of County Road Viewers, meet at the beginning of the proposed road, on July 18, 1905 and view and lay out said road according to law.

The application of John Stenbala for county aid was granted, and the Clerk instructed and ordered to draw in the contingent fund for \$15.99. The petition of the La Grande Real Estate Association asking for a settlement of taxes for the years 1898, 1899 and 1900 was denied.

In the matter of the proposed road petitioned for by D McDonald et al. It was ordered that the County Board of Road Viewers meet at the beginning of said proposed road on the 21st day of July, 1905, and view, lay out said road as by law directed.

In the matter of the application of John Martin for transportation to Pendleton, Oregon. It was ordered that the Clerk draw a warrant on the contingent fund in favor of M A Harrison, County Judge for \$4.00. The official Bond of J B Gilman, as County Clerk, was approved.

In the matter of the Road petitioned by C Plant et al. The protest of the O B & N Co., was filed and duly allowed and approved by the Court.
