
Many questions have been asked at this office in regard to the game laws io regard to certain countles as to grouse, pheseants, etc. We therefore publish the following from the General Laws of Oregon and the act of the last legislature, 1905, giving the act at at to counties east of the Cascades: Sec. 2021, It shall be unlawful at

any time in that portion of the State of Oregon lying east of the Cascade mountains, to hunt, pursue, take, kill, injure, destroy, or have in possession, except for scientific or breeding purposes, or to sell or offer for sale, bartes or exchange, any pheasant, except native pheasants (sometimes called ruffied grouse); or to hunt, pursue, take, kill, injure, destroy, or have in possession, except for scientific or breeding purposes, or sell or offer for sale, barter or exchange, any sage hen, sage cock, grouse or native pheneant sometimes called ruffled grouse), at any time between the first day of Decomper of each year and the fifteenth day of August of the following year; or to hunt, pursue, take, kill, injure or destroy, or have in possession, except for scientific or breeding purposes, or to sell or offer for sale, barter or exchange, any quail, at any time except between the second Saturday in September of each year and the third Tuesday of the same month in the same year; and it shall be unlawful for any person during such open season to kill more than six quell in one day, or more than twalve quall in our week; or to h int, pursee, take, kill, injure, destroy, or have in possession, except for scientific or breeding pur-posse, or to sell or offer for sale, barter or exchange, any ring-neck or Mongolian pheasant or China (Torquatus) pheasant, at any time within five years after the passage of this act, or at any time after five years after the passage of this act, except between the fifteenth day of September of each year and the first day of December following in each year.

Section 2022 of Bellenger and Cotton's Code and Statutes of the State of Oregon was also amended at the last legislature so as to make it unlawful to kill, destroy or have in possession any prairie chicken until the loth day of September, 1909, and after that time it will be unlawful to kill them except from the 15th day of November and the 15th day of September of the following year.

At the last session of the legislature there was also a law enacted amending the statute in regard to deer, which now reads as follows:

Sec. 2010. It shall be unlawful at any time between the first day of November of each year and the 15th day of August of the following year to hunt,


