MORE MUTINY IN THE NAVY

Odessa Russia July 22 Reports from Sebastopol State that the crews of the Black Sea fleet are upon point of mutiny, and maneuvers of the fleet have been canceled as a consequence. At a quarter of the Mischeva, the peasants, who were complaining of the exorbitant rents, were attacked by the Cosacks and infantry. Three were killed and eleven wounded. One hundred and twenty have been arrested.
