Horrible Suicide

South Haven Mich July 24—Disappointed because she could not marry an English nobleman or, emulating the heroine of Rider Haggard's novel, "She", who leaped into fire to renew her youth and beauty—these are the two theories advanced by friends for the self destruction of Miss Lucy Munroe, daughter of the president of three Michigan banks and formerly prominent in Chicago society circles.

Miss Munroe chose a horrible dramatic way to end a life of which she had grown tired. Slipping out of the fine country home of her father, she went to an orchard where she had previously concealed a can of gasoline. She undressed her clothing with the fluid, set it on fire and with Spartan courage waited for the flames to envelope her. Members of the family at the house saw the blaze flaring up among the trees, but it was not until the handsome daughter had been gone for over an hour that they went to investigate and found the charred body.

Emperor's Cruise

Paris July 24—Emperor Nicholas' cruise in the gulf of Finland to meet Emperor William is the subject of much comment in the press. Certain newspapers express the fear that the German emperor will influence the Russian emperor over far eastern matters and will hinder the carrying out of the peace program, while others are of the opinion that Emperor William will seek to estrange Russia from France.

The Journal Des Debats says that the first acts of Emperor Nicholas on his return to Russia will be looked forward to with particular interest.

Holdup Caught

Weiser July 23—Deputy Sheriff Pence went to Ontario, Ore, this afternoon to bring back to this city a man known as John Gideon who was arrested there this morning charged with being the man who held up and robbed the Meadows-Warren stage and took the registered mail from the mail sack, securing about \$300 in money and about \$1200 in gold dust. Gideon had been employed at the Golden Rule mine, where the dust was sent from, up to a few days before the shipment was sent out as a registered package. He had been in the locality of the holdup for the past two months. He seemed to have but little money while at the camp, but at Meadows and here he displayed a large sum of money and was spending it recklessly. The arrest was made at the request of Manager Krigbaum, who telephoned Deputy Sheriff Pence at he had undisputed evidence against Gideon.

Notice To Water Consumers

All persons knowing themselves to be in arrears for city water are hereby notified to call at the office of the city Recorder and settle at once. In order that there may be no misapprehension we cite the customer to the following section of the city ordinance. This ordinance will be in force.

Section 28—The water rates shall be payable in advance at the office of the water superintendent on the first day of each month (except for meters which are payable on the first day of the succeeding month), and if not paid within the first ten days the water will be shut off the premises, as provided in Sections 26 and 27.

Later ordinance provides that water rates shall be payable to City Recorder instead of Water Superintendent.
